It's income tax time again and volunteers will be on hand to help seniors file their income taxes.

The office will be on the second floor of the Federal Building (Post Office) and will be open every Wednesday and Friday from 1 to 4 p.m. beginning February 1st and ending on April 12th. Computers will be used and clients can e-file their tax returns through the Internet.

With the help of volunteers, the AARP Tax-Aide program provides free tax counseling and preparation services to millions of low and middle income taxpayers, with special attention to those over 60 years of age. This AARP program is the nation's largest free volunteer-run tax counseling and preparation service.
