REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- A. Call Cathe Barnabee at (847) 673-1917 between April 1 and May 16 and ask to register for the Latin Pedagogy Workshop. WE CONSIDER THIS CALL A COMMITMENT TO THE WORKSHOP. You will receive a mailing before the end of May, 2008 to confirm your registration.
- B. At National-Louis on July 7th, you will complete the registration forms and pay fees during the registration period from 11:15 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. Please check into the hotel prior to arriving at National-Louis.
