## 2008 Youth Toumament Rules

1. This toumament is open to youth sanctioned members of the Greater Danbury USBC Association. No partic ipation cards will be issued.
2. All USBC rules shall govem this toumament.
3. All bowlers will bowl three games in the each event.
4. A bowler desiring to bowl either the singles or doubles event must enter both. When a bowler competes more than once, their first appearance in each event shall count towardsall events score. In no case shall the same individual be permitted to place more than once in the prize list for position standing. Partic ipation in singles and doubles shall be unlimited but the bowler may partic ipate only once with the same partner.
5. Blind scores shall not be permitted. Tardy bowlers will receive a zero for each frame missed.
6. Entry fee must accompany entry a pplications. Walk in applications will be accepted. There will be no refund of entry fees after the entry hasbeen processed and squad time a ssigned.
7. Each bowler will use their highest curent league average as of November 29, 2008 based on a minimum of 9 games.

- If no current average is available then the bowler will use their 2007-08 book average.
- If no book average is a vailable the bowler will use their 2008 summer final average of 21 or more games. League final standings sheet must accompany the bowler.
- If none of the above applies - bowlers shall use their highest current league average as of December 6, 2008 - minimum of 9 games.
- If there is no established a verage as of this date the bowler must bowl sc ratch.
- ALLAVERAGES MUST BE VERIFIED - Youth

8. Each Program Direc tor is to certify entering averages and USBC membership. The certifying Program Director must sign the entry application.
9. The toumament shall be handic apped at $100 \%$ of 200 for all Divisions.
10. Teams and Doubles entries will bowl in the exact order as listed on the entry application. Eligible substitutes will be permitted only in the same line up position.
11. ALENTRANTS MUST REPO RTATLEA ST 30 MINUTE'S BEFO RE ASSIGNED SQ UAD TIME.
12. Trophies will be awarded on the basis of at least one trophy for every 10 entries. There will be only one male and one female Scratch \& Handic ap award in all events. In case of a tie co-champions will be awarded trophies.

13. All bowlers shall be eligible for any a chievement awards not previously ea med in the current season. League coaches will be responsible to notify toumament director.
14. Eligible subs shall be permitted. Once substitute bowler has rolled one ball, they must complete the series, except for injury. Once an event has started, no bowler may be replaced, except in case of emergency, which shall be detemined by the toumament director.
15. To be eligible for "All Events" the bowler must bowl in each event. The bowler's first Team and first Doubles scores will count for "All Events".
16. All bowlers must sign in 30 minutes before squad time. No bowler is allowed outside the bowler's circle once the toumament has started without official permission. No unauthorized persons will be permitted in the bowler'scircle.
17. There sha ll be NO SMOKING OR DRINKING OF ALCOHOLC BEVERAGES OR PLAYING OF GAME MACHINES while to umament is in progress.
18. NO COACHING of bowlers is pemitted while toumament is in progress. (By parents or coaches) (Youth bowlers can help each other.) Only positive encouragement will be permitted.
19. In the event a division does not have enough entries, the toumament director can close said division and move said bowlers into the next higher division, or combine male and female divisions.
20. Any protest affecting eligibility or general pla ying rules must be confirmed in writing to the toumament director not later than 7 days after the close of the toumament. Errors in scoring must be reported to the toumament director within 24 hours.
21. Failure to comply shall result in disqualific ation - subject to a decision by the touma ment committee.
22. The to umament director will rule on all matters not herein noted. If the weather is bad, the toumament director will make the decision as to whether the toumament is postponed. Please listen to WICC 600 AM, WLAD 800 AM, WEBE 108FM, or WRKI 95 FM

3. If no current average is a vailable and no book average is a vailable, the bowler will use their 2007 summer final average with more than 21 games.
4. If none of the above applies - bowlers shall use their highest curent league average as of December 6, 2008 - minimum of 9 games.
5. If there is no established average as of this date, the bowler must bowl scratch.
6. AL AVERAGES MUST BE VERIFIED. EACH YOUTH DIRECTOR SHAL PROVIDE A CURRENT LEAGUE SHEET DATED DECEMBER 6, 2008.

Each coach or instructor is to certify averages and USBC membership. The certifying coach must sign the entry application.
