### **◆ ENTRY INFORMATION ◆**

A. entries close at 12 noon, August 15, 2001. Fees must accompany entries. The Club and/or its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by owner or agent of the owner. The Club and its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete nor for entering the same dog twice.

B. Entry fees will NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly. There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

C. Declination of entries. The participating Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof

D. If, because of riots civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made

### **◆ TRANSFER OF ENTRY TO BEST OF BREED ◆**

Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular confirmation judging at the show

### **◆ JUDGING ◆**

The judging will start promptly. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. Unentered dogs are not allowed in the show area.

### **◆ TROPHIES ◆**

A. Trophy certificates will be given to individuals handling the dog in the ring and trophies may be obtained at the Trophy Table any time during show hours prior to Best of Breed Judging.

B. All Trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

C. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
