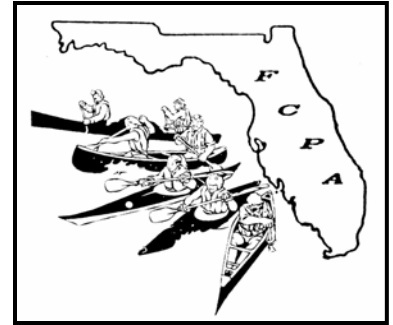

*To qualify for an Annual Award, paddlers must complete at least 5 championship points races in a single class. Short course points: 1/2 of full course points. At the end of the year, award points are based on individual paddler's 9 best races. The 3 paddlers with the most points in each class will receive recognition. Only current FCPA members (whose dues are paid up on the day of the race) qualify for championship points. Points are not awarded retroactively.*

## 1st COAST OFFSHORE RACE #1

March 28/09

In Ormond Beach, hosted by Ormond Beach Kayak Center. The race course was 9.7 miles; Seas were 4-6 feet; SW winds 15-20 kts with higher gusts. Set waves approached the line of travel from 4 o'clock with wind waves coming from 6-7 o'clock. The conditions rewarded both skill and conditioning, as linking runs required maintaining a high boat speed and using the wind waves to catch the faster moving set waves. The start was challenging, with only two paddlers - Reid Hyle and Andy Morris - making it through the surf zone cleanly. Reid wasted little time putting the field behind him and wasn't seen again until greeting everyone on the beach. As Reid said afterwards there were plenty of runs out there, but no freebies... you had to work for them.

Andy Morris, **Chris Borgert**, and Aaron Hamerling diced most of the race, with Borgert opening a slight lead a few minutes before the finish. Of course, the moment I relaxed I would wallow a bit and Andy would be ahead of me again or back up with me. There was not much rest.....until I fell out of the boat 50 yards off the beach! Floating in your pfd is restful... but was discouraging watching Andy pass me onto the beach like it was a walk in the park! Aaron was close behind, with only a minute separating the three.

**Ed Joy** came 5th... Ed had some problems at the start... he dumped in the shore break and his leash came loose; lost his boat and had to collect it, then restart from the beach, at least 10 minutes back, probably more.....after bending his rudder crossing the sand bar at the start and paddling the distance without the luxury of a rudder, steering with his paddle.

David Toppi was within 200 yards at about 1:30, but had trouble getting back in; I think he was nervous about destroying his ultra light weight Epic ski. Those things are like potato chips... fast, but they crack easily. He swept the field, finishing without damaging his ultra light Epic layup, a good feat in the strong conditions.

All in all, a good start to the series and wonderful conditions for surf skis. Couldn't ask for more, except maybe a wind sock attached to Hyle's rudder!

(We had considerable difficulty starting the race due to congested beach access, but that logistical difficulty has been solved and will not hinder Race #2)

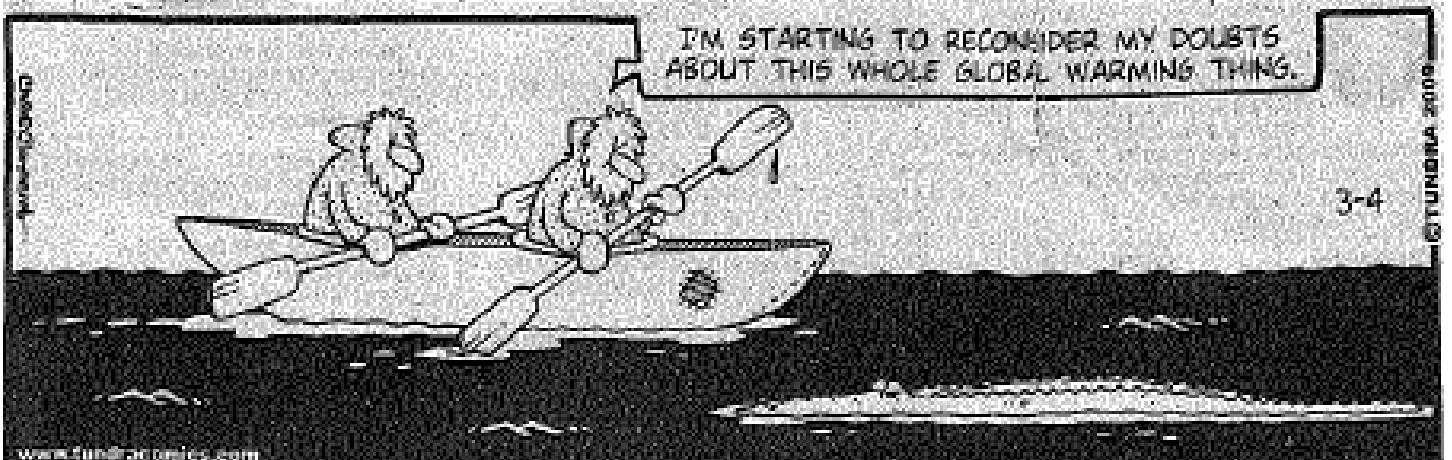
