More Important HTML Tags

Tables:

- **<table>** begins constructing a table in the browser
- **<table border="1-0">** defines the thickness of the lines surrounding the tables (when border is not attributed default is no lines). 1 is the thinnest and increases to 10.
- **<table cellpadding="1-0">** creates space between the lines of the border and the text.
- **<colgroup span="1-0">** defines the number of columns
- **<col>** defines a column
- **<col width="1-0">** defines the width of an entire column in number of pixels
- **<tr>** defines a new table row
- **<td>** defines the table data in an individual cell
- **<td width="1-0">** defines the width of an individual cell in number of pixels
- **<td align="left, right, justify, center">** horizontal alignment
- **<td valign="top, middle, bottom, baseline">** vertical alignment
- **<th>** table header (a bold heading for a spreadsheet-like table)

Tags for Hyperlinks:

- **** removes the hyperlink color line (good for images)
- **** opens the linked page in a separate window
- **** removes the underline from text based hyperlinks
- **** tells the browser to jump to the name anchor on this same page
- **** names an area of text that is referenced by a # link

Text Tags:

- **<!--.....-->** indicates an embedded note (free text)
- **<pre>** displays text exactly how it is presented in the editor (preformatted)
