

Railer's Baseball Team Falls In First Game of Their 1960 Dist. Tournament

Lincoln's Railsplitters lost the opening game of the 1960 District Baseball Tournament on the Lincoln diamond. Terry Bruce and McLean-Waynesville proved too much for Coach Paul Johnson's squad, beating the Railers 5-0.

Bruce provided the afternoon's highlight pitching no-hit, no-run baseball. He had a no-hitting go-inning when Tom Zurkammer drilled a grounder through the Colt's shortstop's legs. With Zurkammer on second, the big question came up — was it a hit or an error on the shortstop?

After Bruce set down the rest of the Lincoln batters without damage, the scorers got into a huddle and issued the verdict. The shortstop had committed an error and the game was called a no-hit performance by the Colt hurler.

McLean-Waynesville scored one run in the first inning, one in the fourth inning, and three big runs in the fifth.

In the second game, the Yellow-jackets of Beason High defeated Armstrong's Mustangs 4-1.

In the District Final, Beason kept McLean-Waynesville in check as Bob Guy pitched the Yellowjackets to a 9-4 win. Danny White, Beason shortstop was the hitting star of the day, getting three hits, a single, double, and a triple. Seven Beason hits and five Colt errors were more than enough for Beason.
