

23 Tenets of Universal Doctrine

I do not believe that there is, can be, or should be one specific set of religious beliefs that everyone everywhere can or should believe, as this seems to go against the natural law and the warnings of at least a few sacred texts. That said, these are the Truths that I believe to be common in all valid religions:

- 1.** There is a Source of all Creation.
- 2.** This Creator Source is present, all knowing, all-powerful, and perfect beyond human comprehension.
- 3.** Words, names, and titles for the Creator Source are attempts to describe that which cannot be described in Its totality, at least not while still mortal.

- 8.** Separation from the Creator Source is suffering and pain.
- 9.** Attunement with the Creator Source is peace and happiness.
- 10.** There have been prophets, holy men, saviors, and saints (also known as Enlightened and Divine Beings) sent from and Attuned with the Creator Source for the purpose of teaching others the path of Attunement with the Creator Source.
- 11.** All things—including miracles, magic, healings, etc.—are possible through the power of the Creator Source, which allows or Wills all things.
- 12.** The Creator Source works through Attuned Beings for the purpose of Divine revelations or teachings.
- 13.** The path of Attunement with the Creator Source lies in emulating and imitating the Enlightened Beings.
- 14.** Transference of Attunement or bestowal of Attunement with the Creator Source is possible, and is often passed in some way from a master to a prominent or otherwise suitably receptive disciple/student.
- 15.** All people should strive to treat others with kindness and compassion, as we are all the children of the Creator Source, and also because laws of Cause and Effect (Karma) show that we shall reap as we sow.
- 16.** People should not treat others in ways that are harmful or negative, if only because the laws Karma show that most people tend to act accordingly to the manner in which they themselves are treated.
- 17.** All people are co-creators of reality, in that everything we think, say, and do has some degree of influence on our surroundings and the way in which we perceive them.
- 18.** People should avoid all forms of excess, as these lead to physical, mental, and spiritual dis-eases.
- 19.** The path of moderation is often the wisest path to take, as this encourages and cultivates balance and harmony in mind, body, and soul.
- 20.** People should strive to focus on their similarities and equal devotion to the Creator Source instead of engaging in arguments over honestly held beliefs and practices that may appear different on the surface.
- 21.** Each person is ultimately meant to be Sovereign unto their Self, and attempts to control another's true Will are inherently evil.
- 22.** The moment one begins upon the path of Self-Realization, the Divine Beings immediately begin to aid the aspirant in the Completion of the Work.
