

FANSIPAN PEAK FOR 6D/5N DISCOVER THE SUMMIT OF INDOCHINA

Day 01: Hanoi – Lao Cai by night train

- 20h30 pick up at your hotel, transfer to Hanoi railway station for the night train at 22h00,
- You will sleep 8hrs on the train with last stop is Lao Cai station

Services:

Transfer, train ticket (Class: soft berths in a cabin with a/c)

Day 02: Lao Cai -Sa Pa – The elevation 2100m with 6-7hrs trek

- 06h00 pick up at station to Sapa for shower and breakfast
- 09h00 a jeep upto ***Tram Ton Pass via Silver waterfall***, Heavenly Gate that is famous for its stunning universal view of Sapa and Lai Chau province
- Start trekking up to 2100m high with picnic lunch en-route.
- You and your guide, porter will put together camping and prepare for dinner
- Sitting around the campfire is friendly and adventurous. This may be once in a lifetime experience.

Services:

Transfer, tour guide, porter, sleeping bags, tents, entrance fees, climbing insurance and meals (B + L + D)

Day 03: 7-8hrs Experience the roof of Indochina 3143 m

- This day is just for you and your tour guide to climb up the summit, the porter is required to stay at the camp to look after all your gears
- At the top you will be a vanquisher.
- Take your time to enjoy yourself, take pictures to your collections
- Enjoy your lunch then descend to the camp for dinner and overnight.

Services:

Tour guide, porter, sleeping bags, tents, entrance fees, climbing insurance and meals (B + L + D)

Day 04: 5-6hr on new trails down to Sapa via Shin Chai village

- Head down hillsides to Shin Chai village of the Black H'mong minority
- After a picnic lunch, A standby jeep to return you to Sa Pa
- Check in the hotel for a relaxing night.

Services:

Transfer, tour guide, porter, entrance fees, climbing insurance, hotel 2* and meals (B + L)

Day 05: 4-5hrs Trek throughout 3 different minority villages

- Today we will discover and learn to know about the traditional culture and customs of 3 different hill tribes. They are the Black H'Mong, the Dzay and the Red Dzao living in Lao Chai, Ta Van and Giang Ta Chai hamlets
- Enjoy a special lunch with a local family
- Then by jeep to return to the hotel
- Collect your gear, head down Lao Cai station for a night train back to Hanoi at 20h30 - The trip ends.

Services:

Transfer, tour guide, entrance fees, train ticket (same class) and meals (B + L)

Day 06: Free Time At Hanoi.
