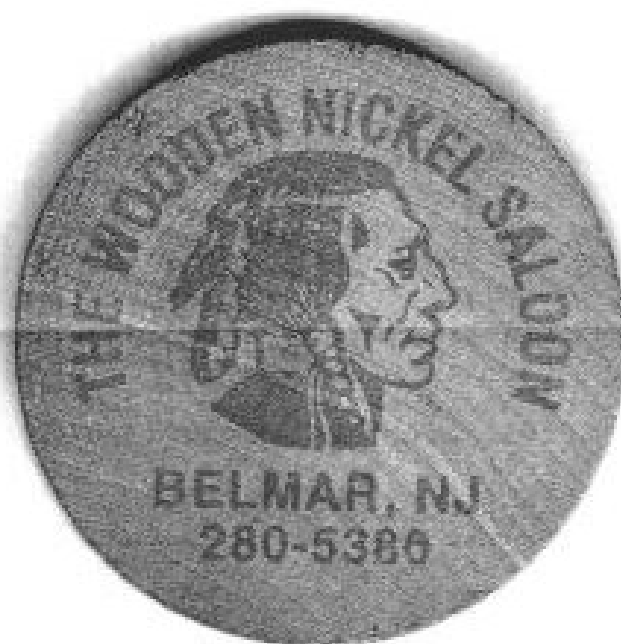

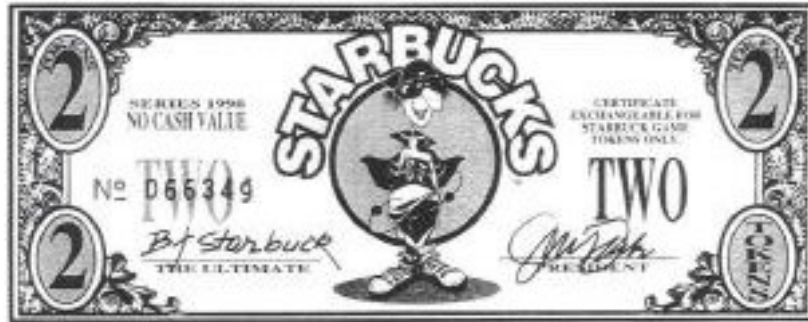

OUTSIDE OF THESE DOG TAGS, VERY FEW EXONUMIA ITEMS WERE ISSUED FROM THESE TOWNS. IN THE 1970'S A WOODEN NICKEL WAS ISSUED BY A DONUT SHOP ON RT. 571 IN CASSVILLE.
