Golf Course aerification continues with top-dressing. Temporary greens will have to be in play occasionally. Suggestion made to keep temp. greens mowed. Fairway coring next with rolling hole closures. Juniper bushes were removed adjoining tee #14. Large rock will remain there with the addition of an ornamental tree. Also the dead tree behind #12 green was discussed. Options will be discussed next meeting. There were also 10 trees planted on the golf course courtesy of the new recreation center.

Special Projects- Gary Turzak – Funding for approved projects not/under funded. Planning Committee to approve funds. New projects in the pipeline include new tee on Hole #4 and re-work #9 tee.
