Captain's Message-Tom Knoflick

A reminder about playing READY GOLF:

- . Take your driver cover off and leave it off until the round is complete
- . The first golfer ready should tee off. Don't stand on "honors".
- . Be aware of the group in FRONT of you. Look AHEAD not behind.
- . Think about your next shot as you drive to your ball.
- . Minimize practice swings on the course. One is enough.
- . Watch where your ball lands and line it up with something on the course so time is not lost
- . Take several clubs with you as you walk to your ball.
- . Don't worry about who is away. When it is safe to hit make sure you are ready.
- . Get your pre-shot routine completed while others are hitting. Then hit it!
- . Drive the cart as a team. While one player walks to his ball, the other player drives to his ball. DO NOT wait for player to return to the cart before proceeding to the next ball.
- . The first player whose ball is on the green should drive the cart to the appropriate position behind or beside the green.
- . Study your line of putt while others are preparing to putt.
- . Leave the green and immediately drive to the next tee. Then record your scores. Then put your clubs away and take out the club you use next.
