Opinion Survey on the Golf Course Master Plan

Congratulations and thank you for responding so well to the survey! At 52%, the Men's Nine Hole Golf Club was number one.

The results have been posted on the Lake Wildwood web site (www.lwwa.org -> Activities -> Golf -> Golf Committee -> GCMP Opinion Survey Results. As of this writing, it is just the statistics which are available. However, by the time that you read this, all of the comments should be posted also. PLEASE NOTE: The files are Adobe PDF files and when you first see them the print may look small, but you can fix this. If you look in the middle of the tool bar on your Adobe Reader, you will see "zoom" controls. Click the plus sign and things will get bigger and you can do it multiple times. For those without a computer, a copy of the results will be available for browsing at the Pro Shop or, if you want your own personal copy, ask a friend with a computer to print one for you.

Projects and the Survey

Top items in the survey results were cart path work on #13 & #14, construction of elevated forward tees and conversion of native grass areas. The Golf Committee was working on the first two and will continue to do so and is passing its approval of the third to the GCS. We will be studying the results further as well as available monies to pay for projects and will be developing a long range plan.

The Limited Annual

A special provision of the limited (75 round) annual this year is that you will only be charged for ½ round if you play in the 9ers shotgun on Tuesdays.* Therefore you can play every Tuesday of the year and still have 50 rounds left for other days. However, if you decide to play another 9 holes later on Tuesday, that's just like playing them any other day of the week and would cost you for a full round.

* For dual members, this ½ round dispensation is only for those whose designated preferred tee time is with the Men's 9-Hole Club.
