OR

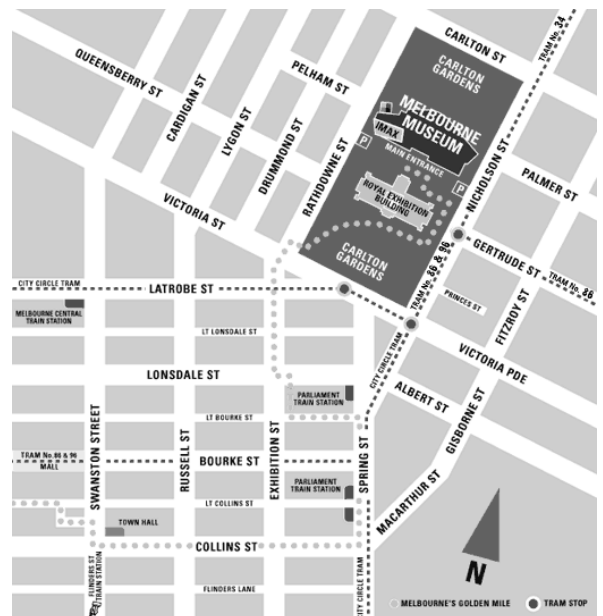
Take the free City Circle Tram to Carlton Gardens
