ELIGIBILITY:

1. The applicant must be a currently enrolled undergraduate student attending Texas A&M University in College Station, TX with at least 90 semester hours.
2. Eligible applicants must have completed at least 25 hours at Texas A&M University in College Station, TX and maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.25.
3. The applicant must be a graduate of a Medina County High School.
4. The applicant will be eligible for only one College Senior Scholarship.
5. Scholarship(s) will be awarded after the recipient(s) has provided official documentation of cumulative GPA and current enrollment at Texas A & M University in College Station, TX. Official documentation of enrollment and grade point average include: bonfire grade report, official transcript, or other official documentation provided by Texas A&M University in College Station, TX.



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6. Eligible applicants will be awarded the scholarship for the following enrolled semester at Texas A&M University in College Station, TX. Scholarship applicants applying in the spring will be awarded the scholarship for the subsequent currently enrolled Fall semester and applicants applying in the Fall will be awarded the scholarship for the subsequent currently enrolled spring semester.
7. The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the amount of available scholarship funds.
8. The Scholarship Committee will be appointed by the President, consisting of members residing in Medina County. The Committee will be responsible for reviewing the College Senior applications and awarding the scholarship to all students who meet all the requirements and guidelines.
