

## FEE SCHEDULE

Lesson fees are \$50/month for weekly, 1/2 hour lessons, with family rates for additional students, as indicated below. Lesson fees are due the first lesson of every month. There is a \$5.00 late fee if the fee is paid beyond the first week.

### MONTHLY FEES

One student/one private lesson: \$50/month

One student/two private lessons: \$90/month (e.g., violin & piano)

Addition of second child/one private lesson: \$40/month

Addition of third child/one private lesson: \$30/month

Addition of fourth child/one private lesson: \$20/month

Addition of fifth or more child/one private: \$10/each additional student

### EXAMPLES:

One child studying in the family: one private, 30 minute lesson (violin, viola or piano)--fee is \$50 [**\*\*Note that in the case of very small children, the child's lesson may be 10, 15 or 20 minutes, with the remaining time spent with supervisor of home practice --mom, dad, grandma, etc.]**

One child studying in the family: one violin or viola lesson, one piano scholarship lesson for college bound student--fee is \$50

One child studying in the family: one violin or viola lesson, one piano lesson--fee is  $\$50 + \$40 = \$90$

Two children studying in the family: two violin lessons, two piano lessons--fee is  $\$50 + \$40 + \$30 + \$20 = \$140$

Two children studying in the family: one takes a violin lesson, and both take piano lessons--fee is  $\$50 + \$40 + \$30 = \$120$

Two children & one parent studying in the family: three violin lessons, one piano scholarship lesson for college bound student--fee is  $\$50 + \$40 + \$30 = \$120$

Three children studying in the family: two take a viola lesson, one takes a piano lesson--fee is  $\$50 + \$40 + \$30 = \$120$

NINE children studying in the family: each one takes one violin, viola, cello or piano lesson--fee is  $\$50 + \$40 + \$30 + \$20 + \$10 \times 5 = \$190$ . Each child gets a 15-30 minute private lesson (as age appropriate) and group playing and music history/theory lesson, as requested.

The flat monthly fee almost always covers four lessons, and occasionally five, per month. On at least one occasion, it covers three lessons (in December). We have two recitals per year, one in May and one in mid-December. If students need to be absent for sleep-away camp or vacations, please inform teacher; parents will not be charged for two-week hiatus from lessons, but only half the lesson fee, if teacher is informed well in advance. No refunds will be given, once lessons are started. Teacher is not responsible for any items left in studio. Consistent no shows/no calls will result in student being placed back on waiting list.
