All mounts in a USPC-sponsored activity should be serviceably sound and healthy. It is recognized, however, that there are many different reasons a mount may be under the care of a Veterinarian and on prescribed medications, either long term or for a short period of time. Mounts requiring legal (permitted), prescribed medication during a Pony Club activity must have a valid Veterinary Letter. The letter must:

- Be on letterhead from that Veterinarian's practice or be stamped with information for that Veterinarian's practice, and
- Include all of the following information.
