Feeding Equipment (per horse)

_____ All feed and hay must be prepared and labeled in such a way that anyone, whether a member of the team or any other individual, is able to step in and feed each mount in the absence of the owner/rider.

Feed can be pre-packaged in PAPER bags – one feeding per bag. Each bag should be clearly labeled with name of mount, rider's name and/or number, what is included in the bag (name of mount and amount of feed, any nutraceuticals, supplements and salt, etc.), and when the 'meal' will be fed (morning, mid-day or evening). All bags need to be placed in a secure container with a lid that a horse cannot remove.

EX: Joey (the pony's name), Janie Doe, ABPC, Competitor #42, ¼ pound of oats, Wed. PM feeding,.
