Riders in the Qualifying Divisions: 1. To be eligible for Championships, a competitor must be at least a C1, 12 years old, and must be entered in one of the QUALIFYING DIVISIONS. DEVELOPING HORSE or RIDER competitor must be at least D3, 12 years old. 2. Any rider who has been eliminated for any reason in any round at a qualifying rally may not compete at Championships. 3. During the Equitation Round, the judge will look for riders to demonstrate a plan, a basic balanced position and a consistent and appropriate pace throughout the jumping round. 4. Round 3 of Show Jumping (SJ) Rally, Qualifying Divisions only , will be run as a "Take-Your-Own-Line" Competition. Please refer to the 2008 Show Jumping Rulebook to answer your questions in how this round is to be conducted.

Riders in the Non-Qualifying Divisions: 1. Competitors entered in the Non-Qualifying division are not eligible for the Show Jumping National Championships. 2. Non-Qualifying Divisions are designed to encourage greater participation in the sport. 3. During the Equitation Round 2, the judge will look for riders to demonstrate a plan, a basic balanced position and a consistent and appropriate pace throughout the jumping round.								
+NOTE: 'Pony A' may not exceed 13.2 hands. 'Pony B' is over 13.2 hands and may not exceed 14.2 hands. 'Horse A & B' is over 14.2 hands. * Number of combinations may be increased to include 2 doubles and/or 1 or 2 triples (no triples for DH/R) if arena is of sufficient size and skill of competitor warrant. **Course length can be longer if the competition arena mandates it because of terrain. (2) For Qualifying Rounds, the first round must start 3 inches higher than minimum.
