



Number Line Squeeter

Rules:

1. The leader thinks of a mystery number and then calls out two numbers such that the mystery number is somewhere between the two numbers.
2. The other children then try to guess the mystery number.
3. When a guess is made, the leader must respond something like, "no, my number is smaller or less than ?" (or my number is larger or greater than ?)
4. Using the number line, two children should hold the boundaries and move them as numbers are guessed and responses are given. Eventually the mystery number will be squeezed between the two brackets.
5. The child who guesses the mystery number becomes the next leader.
