OWNER'S INFORMATION

~Communication

Whilst you have a horse in training, you will be routinely contacted by phone, e-mail or mail regarding your horse at the following times:

- Regular updates regarding health, training and welfare (at least fortnightly)
- When your horse is nominated for a race
- At race acceptance time (after declaration of riders)
- After the race (In the case of large ownership groups, the managing partner will be contacted to discuss the race)

Also, the most important point of contact is on course, on race day. I am always keen to meet with you on race day both pre and post race running.

In the near future, a website will be launched through which owners and potential owners will be able to keep updated on the happenings around the stable. Eventually this will include a password secure section through which owners will be able to obtain specific information regarding their horse.

Personal contact is essential beyond the formal channels outlined above. Should anything untoward happen at any time or a major decision need to be made regarding your horse, every effort will be made to personally get in contact with as many partners as possible in the time available.

At any time, you are more than welcome to contact myself personally on 0449 876 213. Being a hands on trainer, I will often be a little hard to reach. If you cannot get through, please leave a message and I will return your call as early as possible.

You are always welcome to visit the stable complex at any time to have a look around and see your horse(s). Please phone prior to ensure either myself or a staff member is present to welcome you and show you around.

~Training Fee Policy

As of May 2008, the following policy regarding training fees will apply:
All listed fees and charges include GST

- Initial charge, invoiced when horse first enters training: \$350.00

This initial charge occurs once only during each horse's racing career. It covers a worming treatment, tetanus/strangles vaccine and set of steel shoes on arrival, as well as a summer and winter rug. Rugs then remain property of owners and may be taken with the horse at the end of it's career or remain at the stable for use on another horse the owner has in training. If owners choose to use rugs they had purchased for a previous horse at the stable, or send their own rugs with the horse, the initial charge will be lower to reflect rugs not having to be purchased.

After the initial charge, clients will be invoiced monthly for the following :-
Each client is invoiced individually based on percentage ownership of horse(s) in training.

- Daily Training Fee \$55.00
(Includes Equipment Use, Track Rider, E-Trakka and stable rental costs)
- Daily Track Usage Fee and Supplement Levy \$2.20
- Daily Fee For Horse Temporarily Halted In Preparation \$22.00
(For example, a horse temporarily halted by injury. May change depending on level of care required)

~Summary of Other Charges

In providing the best of care for your horse, there are a number of on-costs incurred during his career which must be passed on. On occasions, a client's account will contain one or more of the following:

- Farrier Services
 - Steel Shoes \$99.00
 - Race Plates \$125.00
 - Specialty shoeing, if required, as charged by farrier
- Worming
 - Paste (Six Weekly) \$15.00
 - Stomach Drenching charged by Veterinarian directly if required
- Wyong Race Club Course Proper Gallop \$7.30
- Wyong Race Club Grass Jump Out \$25.00
- Transport as charged by transport company when required
- Dentist/Chiropractor as charged when required
- Veterinarian charges when required are billed direct from Veterinarian to client.

~Racing Fees

- Raceday transport as charged by transport company
- Strapper Fee
 - Normal Race Meeting \$55.00
 - Sunday, Public Holiday, Night Meeting \$110.00
 - Barrier Trial \$33.00

As charged by Racing NSW:

- Non Acceptance Fee
 - Metropolitan \$126.50
 - Provincial \$36.30
 - Country \$24.20
- Scratching Without Vet Certificate (*No charge with vet certificate*)
 - Metropolitan \$275.00
 - Provincial, with no rider declared \$108.90
 - Provincial, with rider declared \$255.20
 - Country, with no rider declared \$84.70
 - Country, with rider declared \$187.00
- Barrier Trial \$154.00

Additional Note:

Group and listed races carry varying nomination and acceptance fees.

Every race in New South Wales carries a \$200 starter's rebate for every runner not receiving prize money and some race clubs also provide additional floating rebates. These are paid to the trainer through the stakes payment system and then offset against the client's account.
