### Rosemont IGCE Show Tickets

Buying your tickets in advance for the International Gift and Collectible Exposition saves lines and time - not to mention money. Advance-purchase tickets for the International Gift and Collectible Exposition are available through the House of Peers (provided this year by the efforts of Jewels of the Carolinas club in Charlotte, NC).

These non-refundable tickets are \$8 for a one-day admission (regular \$10) or \$10 for a two-day admission (regular \$13). One child under 12 admitted free with each paid adult. Every collector receives a Goodie Bag (\$5 value) with the Show program. Please note that all buggies, strollers, carts wagons or similar items are prohibited on the show floor.
