

London offers a few royal sightseeing ‘musts’, therefore in order for you to have a chance to see royalty, you and the kids can create a royal court with paper bags. You can make them in no time and with very basic materials.

Craft Project Directions:

To make this craft project you will need a paper bag (lunch size), scissors, glue, tape, colored construction paper, and crayons. You could also use additional materials to decorate your Queen paper bag puppet if you wish. Create your Queen's face on the paper bag's bottom and her elegant attire on the back side of the paper bag.

- First cut out a large colorful rectangle which is the same width as the paper bag and about 2 inches tall. Cut V shapes with tiny balls at the tops out of the top of the rectangle to transform the piece of paper into a Queen's crown. Make her crown any color you wish. Tape or glue that onto the bottom of the bag.
- Next cut out hair for your Queen, arms, a dress, and a lovely robe from your colored construction paper. Use the picture for a guide or just use your own imagination! Tape or glue these pieces in place. To create her hair cut out a basic rectangle and then trim it into a border shape and fringe the paper.
- Next curl back the paper you fringed with the scissors to give her hair some motion and texture. Next color on her facial features with crayon or marker. Decorate your Queen further with crayons and other materials. Be sure to add colorful jewels to her crown and more! Foil gives the crown an extra sparkle. Add hands and arms to the sides of the bag if you wish. Enjoy Crafting!
