

2006 WAAY Rules

Junior Tykes Division (Born 1998, 1999 & 2000)

- Man-to man only all the time. No double teaming. No full court pressure allowed.

Tykes Division (Born 1996-1997)

- Man to man only with help defence, no zone defence allowed.
- Double team on man with the ball past the free throw extension.
- No triple teaming. Full court press in the last five minutes of the second half.
- **Cannot** full court press if your team is winning by 10 points or more.

PeeWee Division (Born 1994-1995)

- Man to man the whole game until the last five minutes of the second half.
- The teams can play zone defence on the last five minutes of the second half.
- Full court pressure is allowed on the last ten minutes of the second half.
- **Cannot** full court press if your team is winning by 15 points or more.
- Thirty second shot clock will apply in this division administered by the referees.

Junior Tykes, Tykes, and Peewee

- These divisions are for developmental.
- **Even playing time for all players.**
- All players in these three divisions will receive a trophy as a participant.
- The Champions, 2nd place & 3rd place will be engraved on the trophies.
- The WAAY committee members will try to set up an even team selection.

Bantam Division (Born 1992-1993) & Midget Division (Born 1990-1991)

- These two divisions are the competitive divisions.
- Recognition awards in these two divisions: MVP regular season & playoff,
- Best in Defence, Most promising player,
- Best center, Best forward, Best guard, Sportsmanship award, Best coach & maybe some scholarship awards.

Bantam:

- Can make up their own team up to seven players, WAAY will add the three other players on the team.
- All kinds of defence is allowed.
- **Cannot** full court press if your team is winning by 15 points or more.
- Mandatory 5 on 5 off every five minutes until the last ten minutes of the second half.
- Substitution is allowed any time in the last ten minutes of the second half.
- Thirty second shot clock administered by the referees.

Midget:

- Open to any teams who want to join WAAY.
- All kinds of defence is allowed. No mercy kill.
- High school rules applies except for game time and the time outs (2 stop time can be taken any time).

For all divisions except the Midget.

- One time-out each half (one minute running time).
- No carry-over of un-used time outs.
- Five minutes grace period from the schedule game time.
- Must have 5 players to start the game.
- **All trophies and individual awards will now be presented at the Awards Night which will be held a week after the championship games.**
- Two 20 minutes halves running time, until the last two minutes of the second half.
- Stop time on last two minutes.
