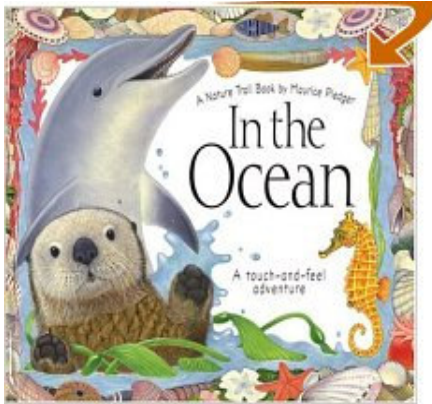
Toilet Training Policy

Please let me know when you feel your child is ready to begin learning to use the potty. This is your responsibility but I will assist you in any way possible. Please advise me as to the terms that you would like used during toilet training. Please understand that your child's learning experiences will not be a private matter. I am responsible for all of the children in my care and must be aware of the other children's whereabouts at all times. You will need to provide me with changes of outfits and undergarments. Soiled clothing will be sent home for laundering. **Please make sure your child wears clothes that he/she can remove without help (NO onesies, belts, snapped pants, etc.)** I will never discipline nor belittle a child who has an accident. This time should always be a positive experience.

Book of the Month



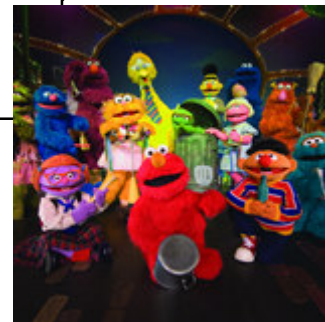
