

Science Fair Project Formats

The following parts of the science fair project are to be finished by Monday February 19, 2007. Each project will be blind judged. This means that no student names will be visible to the judges. His or her science teacher will assign a number to each student. That number is to be written on each of the three components of the project.

1. Science Project Report

- o Format
- o 12 point font
- o Times New Roman
- o Double spaced, front side only, 1 inch margins
- o Order for report

1. Report cover

2. Cover Sheet

Type the title of your project in center of the page.

Type your grade level and assigned number in lower right side of page. Your science teacher will assign your number to you.

DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THIS PAGE.

3. Literature Review

Literature Review is a Works Cited page using the information from your six source cards.

DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THIS REPORT, ONLY YOUR ASSIGNED NUMBER SHOULD BE ON EACH PAGE- UPPER RIGHT CORNER.

4. Experimental Design (Lab Report)

Lab Report must be typed using the school Lab Report template **DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THIS REPORT, ONLY YOUR ASSIGNED NUMBER.**

5. Acknowledgement Page

Thank all those who helped you complete your science fair project. This should be centered and in complete sentences.

2. Science Project Log

- o Format
 1. Loose leaf paper in a three-hole folder with brads, marble copybook, or binder
 2. Hand written with pictures, diagrams, graphs etc.
 3. Sequentially dated entries for each part of the project.
 4. Cover of log should have your assigned number only- **NO NAME**

3. Display Board

- o Display board model set up is on page 11 of the Science Fair booklet.
- o Assigned number is to be placed in the upper right corner of your display board. **YOUR NAME SHOULD NOT BE WRITTEN ON ANYTHING.**
