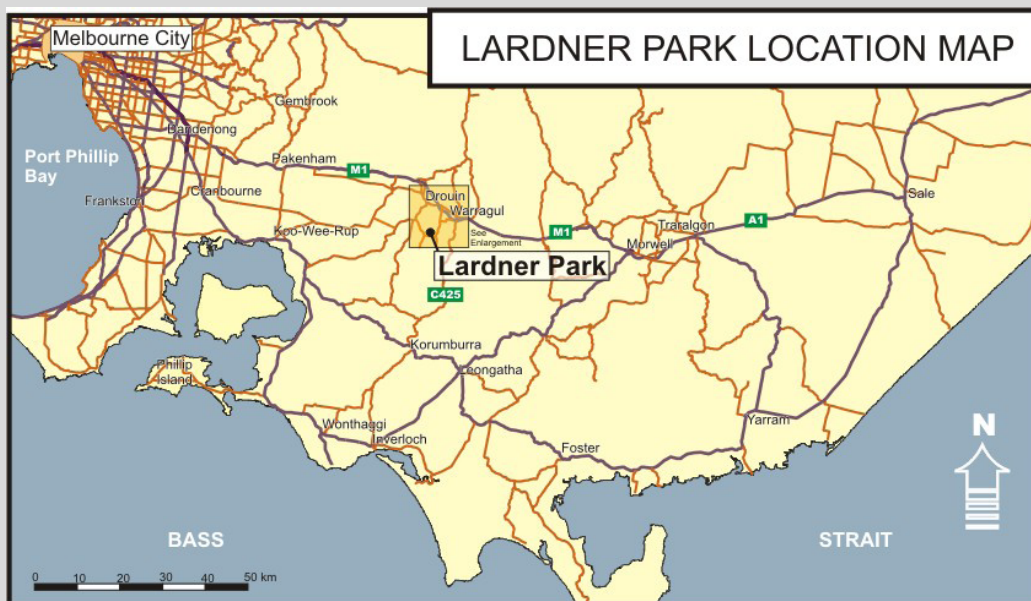

40th ANNUAL INTERCLUB CHALLENGE MOTORKHANA

Supplementary Regulations

1. AUTHORITY

The event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the National Motorkhana Code, and the 2008 VMC Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations or instructions that may be issued. CAMS Permit No. 308/1611/03.

2. EVENT DESCRIPTION

The event will be a multi-club individual and teams motorkhana conducted at Lardner Park, Warragul (Melway Map: 612 U8) on **Sunday, November 16th, 2008**. The surface will be grass.

3. PROMOTER

The event will be promoted and organised by Huntingdale Auto Club Inc., P.O. Box 110, Oakleigh, 3166.

4. KEY OFFICIALS

5. STEWARDS

The Club Steward will be Andrea Fisher.

6. JUDGES OF FACT

Timekeepers and observers will be Judges of Fact as per Article 18.3 of the National Motorkhana Code.

7. ENTRIES

Entries open on October 7th, 2008, and close on **Friday, November 14th 2008**. The entry fee is \$20.00 or \$10.00 for Junior drivers. For an entry to be valid it must be received by Friday, November 14th 2008. **No entries will be taken on the day of the event.**

Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to Huntingdale Auto Club Inc. Entry Forms must be completed in full and accompanied by the entry fee. Post mail entries to Event Secretary at the above address.

Up to **FOUR** drivers may compete in the same vehicle provided this is nominated on the Entry Form. The field will be limited to a maximum of 120 starters.

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the provisions of NCR 83. **Competitors will be required to produce proof of current membership of the club nominated on the entry form.**

8. PERSONS ELIGIBLE

Competitors and drivers must be holders of a current Level 2NS or higher licence issued by CAMS.

9. PARENTAL CONSENT

For any competitor or driver aged less than 18 years on the date of the event, the consent of his/her Parent or Guardian must appear on the Entry Form.

10. SCRUTINY

Scrutiny will commence at 8.30 a.m. and conclude at 10.00 a.m. on the day of the event. All cars must be scrutineered and passed prior to participating in practice (if permitted) or competition. Valid CAMS Licences, Current Club Membership cards, CAMS Vehicle Log Book (if issued) and Competition Record (if issued) must be produced at scrutiny and/or **on request during the meeting.**

11. VEHICLES

Vehicles must comply with Section 6, Schedule A of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and also the rules for Group 4H Motorkhana cars. All vehicles must be adequately muffled. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual. **Wintertread, hand-cut or Rally-type tyres** will NOT be permitted.

12. PASSENGERS

During competition, not more than one passenger, aged at least 12 years may be carried per competing vehicle. Passengers must be a competitor or have completed a passenger declaration, be securely restrained by a seat belt, & not permit any part of their body to protrude from the vehicle, and not assist or hinder the driver in any way. A passenger may be prohibited from taking any further part at the discretion of the Clerk Of Course.

13. SAFETY

Adequate footwear must be worn by all drivers and passengers whilst competing - bare feet, thongs or sandals are not permitted. Where no windscreen is fitted to a vehicle, drivers and passengers must wear adequate eye protection whilst competing. All drivers and passengers must wear at least a lap type seat belt whilst competing.

14. DRIVERS BRIEFING

All drivers must attend the briefing to be held at the event at approx. 10.20 a.m.

15. TESTS

A minimum of four and a maximum of twelve tests will be conducted.

16. START

The event is scheduled to start at 10.30 a.m.

17. RUNNING ORDER

The running order will be advised after the close of entries.

18. INSURANCE

Public Risk Insurance has been affected by the promoter in accordance with Appendix I of the CAMS Manual. All drivers and officials are covered by the Motor Sport Personal Accident Policy.

19. TIMING

Timing will be by means of two digital stopwatches, one nominated as official time, and the other as a backup.

20. PENALTIES

Penalties will be as per the 2008 Victorian Standing Regulations (Motorkhana Appendix) except that reference to slowest time or fastest time shall apply only to that class.

21. EXCLUSION

Failure to comply with an instruction given by any official may result in the competitor being excluded from the event by the Clerk of Course. Leaving the marked competition area in a dangerous manner will result in exclusion from the event.

22. PROTESTS

Any protest/s must be lodged in accordance with the provisions of Part XII of the NCR.

23. ABANDONMENT

The organisers reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59, or it is considered the number of entries, being insufficient.

24. ANTI DOPING POLICY:

During any competition, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A.

In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

25. CLASSES

The competition will be divided into the following classes:

- A Production cars (2WD Engine over Drive Axle, Mid Engine or 4WD), wheelbase up to 2450 mm
- B Production cars (2WD Engine not over Drive Axle), wheelbase up to 2450 mm
- C Production cars (2WD Engine over Drive Axle, Mid Engine or 4WD), wheelbase 2451 - 2660 mm
- D Production cars (2WD Engine not over Drive Axle), wheelbase 2451 - 2660 mm
- E Production cars (2WD or 4WD), wheelbase 2661 mm & over
- F Specials
- J * Juniors (under 18 on the date of the event)
- L * Lady Drivers
- N * Novice Drivers (drivers who have totalled less than 4 class or outright VMC points in any year prior to 2008 or at the discretion of the Clerk of Course).

NOTE: * Competitors eligible for classes J, L or N may nominate to compete in either one of those classes or the appropriate vehicle class. Competitors in classes J, L and N will have their total time multiplied by a handicap factor based on the class of vehicle used as follows:- Class A: 0.90, B: 0.90, C: 0.89, D: 0.88, E: 0.82, F: 1.00.

Competitors must nominate their class and club BEFORE 10.00am (scheduled close of scrutiny).

26. AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to 1st Outright and 1st in each class.

27. HAC INTERCLUB TROPHY

In each class, competitors will be awarded points, ranging from 6 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 6th place. The class points for the six highest point scorers from each club (who become the Team Members) will be totalled.

The **HAC INTERCLUB TROPHY** will be awarded to the Club with the highest total of points, and Medallions to each of the winning Team Members.

28. FACILITIES

Hot and cold food and drinks will be available at the ground, as are toilets. Please DRIVE SLOWLY within and near the venue.

CANCELLATION

If there is extreme rain in the area, the event may be cancelled. If in doubt phone 0425 722 706, 8am to 9pm pre-event.
