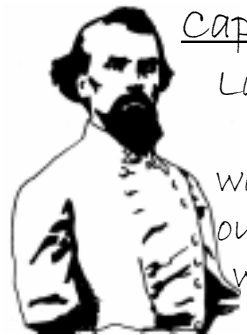


Commander's Corner: Member's of the Tenth,
