

There are 3 characters on stage. A man wearing a scarf, winter hat, and gloves. Another man playing with a snowglobe. And God with a globe.

The men are aligned. The man (CENTERSTAGE) wearing winter garment is facing the audience under spotlight while the other two are turned around, not in stage lighting. He shivers and tries to warm himself up by rubbing his arms. All of a sudden he motions as if an earthquake just happened. He balances himself, then starts to warm himself up again. The "earthquake" happens again. He balances himself, then looks into the sky, shaking his fist in anger. The spotlight moves to the man in the middle (STAGE-R). He turns to face the audience and is seen shaking a snowglobe and trying to see what's inside it. All of a sudden, he motions as if an earthquake just happened. He regains balance, shakes the snowglobe, then motions to another tremor. Regaining balance, he gets upset and shakes his fist into the sky. The spotlight moves to God (STAGE-L). He turns around and is seen holding a globe. He is shaking it and laughs in enjoyment.
