**BRENT BAMBURY LEAVING CBC RADIO'S "ALL IN A DAY"**

**Brent Bambury** will be relinquishing hosting duties of CBC Radio's **All in a Day**, as of the end of the 2004-05 program season. Citing personal reasons, **Bambury** has decided to leave the Ottawa-based show in order to relocate to his native Toronto.

**Bambury** says that **All in a Day** is in great shape, so it is a good time for him to seek new challenges.

**Bambury** began hosting **All in a Day** in September of 2001, and was named permanent host in January of 2002. Within two months of his arrival in the nation's capital, a four-page spread appeared in The Ottawa Citizen heralding him as "king of the radio drive-home show". Ratings shot up, with **All in a Day** going from a 12% audience share in fall of 2002, to 15% in fall of 2004. It is currently the #1 "drive-time" show in the Ottawa region.

CBC happily accommodated **Bambury** when he requested the move. He will continue to make significant contributions to the CBC Radio program schedule, hosting CBC's Saturday morning show **GO!**, and acting as a frequent contributor to other programming. "Brent is well liked and respected by audiences and colleagues alike," says CBC Area Director Robert Renaud. "While we are sorry to see his enormously successful contribution to **All in a Day** come to an end, we are also excited about our future working relationship with him."

**Bambury** will not be leaving the nation's capital for good, though. **GO!**, his comedy/variety show, will be hitting the road for live airings, including a June 25<sup>th</sup> stop in Ottawa.

**Bambury's** final **All in a Day** broadcast will air this summer. A new host has yet to be named.
