Planned Parenthood to Become Real Embassy

In a move that rocked the pro-choice world, PPFA, Planned Parenthood Federation of America announced this week that they will become an independent country, and are turning their 17th street compound into a real embassy.

The organization, which encompasses Planned Parenthood Federation of America, the Alan Guttmacher Institute, Planned Parenthood International, and Republicans for Choice, will be larger than several small African countries.
