Quotations should never be left standing alone.

Make the following quotations part of your own sentence. Do not create a run-on sentence.

Example : “ this math hath bewitched the bosom of my child”

Egeus complained that Lysander had flirted with his daughter and he told Thesusus, “ This man [Lysander] hath bewitched the bosom of my child” (1.1.28)

1. “ I would my father looked but with his eyes” (1.1.58)
2. “ The course of true love never did run smooth” (1.1.136)
3. “ My mistress with a monster is in love” (3.2.6)
4. “ You thief of love! What, have you come by night/ And stol’n love’s heart from him? (3.2.297-298)
5. “ I see are all bent/ To set against me for the merriment “ (3.2.148-49)
