

## Syllabus

### Rules

1. **Be prepared** Bring needed supplies; do work on time; study.
2. **Work hard** Be focused & on task
3. **Be respectful** Cooperate & participate; No whining!
4. Follow all school rules

**Prohibited Items** – The following are not allowed in class:

MP3 players, cell phones (turn ringer off and keep put away), skateboards, gum, food, drinks except water.

### Discipline Policy

Progression of consequences for breaking the rules:

1. Warning
2. Student/Teacher conference during detention
3. Parent contact + NOUP

### Detention

- Students will be given a choice of at least 2 days on which to serve the detention.
- Anyone missing a detention will be required to serve 2 more detentions.
- Detention will be given for the purpose of tutoring to any student falling behind in their work.

### Tardy Policy

Tardies 1-2: Warning

Tardies 3 or more: 1/2 hour detention each time.

\*If tardies continue to be a problem, you may be dropped from the class.

### Absences

- The student is responsible for finding out what he/she missed.
- Any student missing a test must make it up by the end of the week.

### What supplies do I need?

**REQUIRED** to bring **EVERY DAY**:

1. **Binder** with a section for math notes and homework
2. Notebook **paper**
3. Sharpened pencils

### How are grades calculated?

85% on test and quiz scores, 10% on assignments, 5% Notebook score

Grading Scale: >90% A, 80-90% B, 70-80% C, 60-70% D, <60% F

### What are the homework and testing policies?

- Messy or incomplete work will not be accepted. You must show your work and draw diagrams.
- Late work will not be accepted without an excused absence.
- A minimum number of assignments **MUST** be done to qualify to take the unit test for each unit.
- A make-up test will be offered out of class for anyone who scores lower than 70% (C-).
- The make-up test can only bring up your grade by **ONE** letter grade (i.e., a D to a C)

### Tutoring

Tutoring is available during both lunches and occasionally before and after school.

Come in for tutoring **IMMEDIATELY** if you are having trouble. Don't wait until it's too late!
