MSQG GOES GREEN JUNE 6, 2009 AT LONE JACK MO

Quilters have always recycled, cutting up old clothes, feed sacks, etc to make quilts. At this year's spring meeting we will re-affirm our "greenness" and learn about recycling...the quilting way.

Glenda Sha from Liberty Homestead will be our lecturer and teach a class in the morning. Glenda has been in the quilting business for over 30 years and has published over 100 quilt patterns and 27 quilt books including the "Farmhouse Quilts" series. You can check her out on her website www.libertyhomestead.com.

The class will be a wool banner that Glenda has prepared a kit for. The cost of the kit is \$25 and Glenda expects that most of the students will be able to complete the project in the class! No more UFOs! The cost of the class is \$10 and is limited to 25 people. The class will run from 9 am to 11 am. No machine required!

The annual meeting will start at 11:30. Included in your meeting fee will be lunch, Glenda's lecture, and your ticket to Powell Gardens*. There will be lots of other goodies as well. MSQG members will have the opportunity to vote on your new board members.

Show & Tell: What is a MSQG meeting without Show and Tell! This time we are asking that you bring one or two scrap quilts..new or old.

UFO's and orphans: Please bring any orphan blocks or UFOs that you know you are not going to finish. We will set up a table for trades and adoptions.

Friendship Block: Get your green and cream scraps and make a Log Cabin Block. Start with a dark blue center that is 2 1/2 inch square. Make your strips 2 1/2 inch and finish up with a finished block of 14 1/2 inches. You should have 3 green and 3 creams. A name will be drawn to win these blocks from contributors!

For those that arrive early, the Lone Jack Civil War Museum will open at 10 am. It is located just a short distance south of 50 Hwy on 150 Hwy. just north of the Community building. There is a small fee of \$3 to see the museum.

From the office of the Secretary – MSQG Summary of March 7, 2009 Board Meeting

The Board of Directors of the Missouri State Quilters Guild met on March 7, 2009, at Satin Stitches Quilt shop in Columbia, Missouri. Those present were board members Cheri' Hofeldt, Linda Hammontree, Sharon Harmon, Donna Reed, Ellen O'Bryan, Susan Bell, Joy Taylor, and Pamela Williams. MSQG guild members present were Terri Kanyuck, Toby Lischko, Pat Smith and Gerri Friese. The meeting was called to order at 10:10 a.m. by the president, Cheri' Hofeldt, and introductions were made.

The discussions of the January internet board meeting were reaffirmed and approved. Minutes of the May 3, 2008, board meeting were corrected to read, "Donna Reed was appointed by president Susan Ketcherside to the board and named membership chairman. Cheri' Hofeldt was elected by the board to be president for one year."

Joy Taylor, treasurer reported that as of February 28 the checking account balance is \$507.32. There is \$12,582.10 in the savings account and \$25,003.32 in the Bank of America CD.

Fall Retreat: Terri Kanyuck gave a final report on the 2008 Fall Retreat. One hundred and twenty-two members attended the retreat. Terri reported a loss of \$1,513.81. 2009 Retreat: There was a discussion regarding vendors resulting in action that vendors will be charged for their sleeping room, vending room, a portion of the storeroom, plus the tax. The Inn at the Grand Glaize charged \$65 per room in 2008 and will charge \$67 per room in 2009. Action was taken to reduce the cost to members of the fall retreat, MSQG will subsidize \$2000 toward expenses of 2009 Fall retreat.

Annual meeting: Linda Hammontree reported on the plans for the 2009 meeting at the Lone Jack Community Center in Lone Jack, Missouri. Glenda Sha from Liberty Homestead will be the speaker and will also teach a class the morning of the meeting. Following the meeting we will travel seven miles to view the new quilt garden at Powell Gardens. Linda showed us a sample of the friendship block. A box lunch will be provided. Voting for 6 board positions will also take place. Linda said that she has received a lot of interest from non-members about this meeting.

Nominating: Nellie Mueller sent her report via Donna Reed. She submitted the ballot and the nominating committee report that will be included in the next Ravelings.

2009 Fall Retreat: Dates for the Fall Retreat are September 25, 26, & 27. Billy Lauder will be the guest speaker and teacher. Toby has seven other teachers lined up for 2 full day classes and 8 half day classes: Delores Keaton, Cheri' Hofeldt, Barb Bolesta, Linda Hammontree, Nellie Mueller, Nancy Barnes, and Carol Kearney. Specialty Quilts, Satin Stitches, and Carol Kearney will be the vendors. On Friday night there will be demos from the vendors, a trivia night, and Terri Kanyuck with a 'long-arm' skit. Someone is still needed to be the 2010 retreat chairman.

Membership: Donna Reed reported that we have a total membership of 264 with lots of inquiries. Member concerns regarding membership expiration date will be addressed. She reminded us that the renewal date is on everyone's MSQG membership card and on their MSQG directory. This reminder will also be put in the Ravelings. A call to Donna call will always clear it up, too

Following a discussion about the logo of MSQG, a motion was made by Linda Hammontree that "the minutes be amended that THE OFFICIAL MISSOURI STAR PUBLIC DOMAIN BLOCK LOGO REPLACE ANY PREVIOUS LOGO & INSIGNIAS. Motion carried.

Cheri' Hofeldt and Donna Reed will be attending a meeting of the River Heritage Quilt Guild to promote MSQG to the women in that part of the state.

The next board meeting will be held during the meeting at Lone Jack on June 6. All items to be presented for the agenda must be submitted to Cheri' Hofeldt no later than June 1.
