Whether you are a new or returning student, I want to extend a warm welcome to you. I'm pleased that you've chosen to continue your education here in Boston.

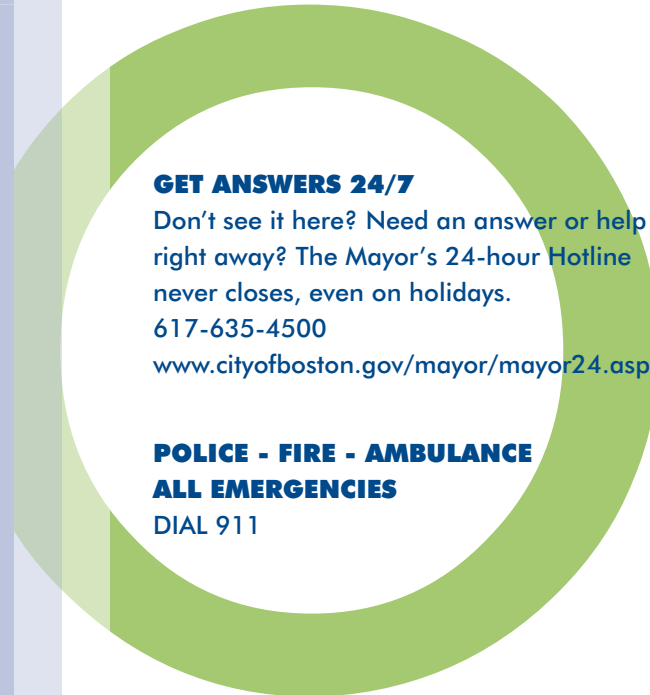
