

How to Get to Heaven

There is one being who is three persons: God, Jesus, and the Spirit. They are the ones who made the angels, the heavens, and the earth. Jesus commanded us to be perfect like our Father (who is in heaven) is perfect. To be perfect is to obey what Jesus said are the two greatest laws:

"love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind"

and

"Love your neighbor as yourself." -

Mark 12:30-31.

Anything less than perfect is always disobedience in God's eyes. The punishment for breaking God's Law is death, imprisonment in Hell, and eternal suffering:

"they will go away into eternal punishment" -

Matthew 25:46.

No one starts out with eternal life and everyone has sinned:

"Anyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life in him."

- 1 John 3:15.

God however wanted to be loved perfectly and to show his perfect love, so he chose to rescue millions of sinners (those who break his Law). But he didn't want to do injustice to himself by not avenging himself for what they did, so Jesus, volunteered to be born as a human, and to obedient to God in the place of those God chose to save and to also be punished in their place. That is why Scripture says,

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son that whoever believes in him will not perish but have eternal life." - John 3:16.

And Jesus did come to earth, and he was born as a human: born of Mary and the Holy Spirit. He obeyed God perfectly and God avenged himself upon his only Son, taking out his perfect anger upon him; causing him to suffer the pain that those he died for deserved; suffering for all of their past and future sins. God also required that Jesus' blood also be shed in their place, and that he be executed while hanging

on a tree, and his blood was shed and he was hung on a tree and died. After three days he was brought back to life just as. God will also bring back to life any of the ones he saved at the last day. No one can turn to God on their own, so God turns their heart to him, this is why Scripture says,

"No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day." -

John 6:44.

Whoever believes this message and asks God to forgive them with a contrite heart will immediately be forgiven of their past and future sins, and be given a forever pure and eternal spirit. And if you are forgiven; when you die you will go to Heaven. Moses and Jesus taught that fact when teaching that our bodies of flesh cannot survive in heaven because of God's glory, which just like the sun will destroy you if you get too close to it. Jesus said,

"No one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and of the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but Spirit gives birth to spirit." - John 3:5-6.

And the water that is required for us to be born again is God's word (specifically the message of salvation, also called, the "gospel"):

"Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word" - Ephesians 4:25-26.

The spirit of a forgiven person will resist the evil that their body wants to do until their body is changed by God when He returns. When it is changed it will no longer desire to sin. The mind of a forgiven person is also controlled by the Holy Spirit. Paul said,

"The mind of the sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace; the sinful mind is hostile to God. It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God. You, however are controlled not by the sinful nature, but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you."

Romans. 8:6-9

What To Do Once You Are Saved

"Shall we sin because we are no longer under the law but under grace? By no means!"

"If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching."

"Fear him who after the killing of the body, has the power to throw you into hell."

"Get wisdom, get understanding; do not forget my words or swerve from them... Be wise... Do not be like the horse or mule which have no understanding"

""Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

"do not worry about your life, what you will eat; or your body, what you will wear."

"Do not be anxious about anything"

"love your enemies, do good to them and lend to them without expecting anything back... Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful"

"When you give a luncheon or a dinner, do not invite your friends, your brothers or relatives, or your rich neighbors; if you do, they may invite you back and so you will be repaid. But when you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind, and you will be blessed."

"If a brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over. But if he will not listen, take one or two brothers along, so that, 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.' If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, treat him as you would a pagan or a tax collector."

"you must not associate with anyone who calls himself a brother but is sexually immoral or greedy, an idolater or a slanderer, a drunkard or a swindler. With such a man do not even eat."

"Endure hardship as discipline; God is treating you as sons."

"Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up. If he has sinned, he will be forgiven."

"teach older women... not to be slanderers or addicted to much wine"

"Do not join with those who drink too much wine"

"Give beer to those who are perishing, wine to those who are in anguish"

"Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling."

"Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—"

"Be wise in the way you act towards outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone."

"Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give a reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, keeping a clear conscience"

"Rescue those being led away to death; hold back those staggering towards the slaughter. If you say, 'But we knew nothing about this,' does not he who weighs the heart perceive it? Does not the one who guards your life know it? Will he not repay each person according to what he has done?"

"If anyone speaks in a tongue, two—or at the most three—should speak, one at a time, and someone must interpret. If there is no interpreter, the speaker should keep quiet in the church and speak to himself and God."

"As in all the congregations of the saints, wives should remain silent in the churches. They are not allowed to speak, but must be in submission, as the Law says. ...she must be silent."

"Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord" "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts towards God."

"Praise Yahweh with the harp; make music to him... strike the tambourine, play the melodious harp and lyre"

"Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves... judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy"

"Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world."

"Slaves, obey your earthly masters with respect and fear, and with sincerity of heart, just as you would obey Christ... Masters, treat your slaves in the same way. Do not threaten them"

"Do not let your heart envy sinners, but always be zealous for the fear of Yahweh. For you there is surely a future and your hope will not be cut off."

"Do not boast about tomorrow... Instead you ought to say, 'If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that.'"

"Let not the wise man boast of his wisdom, or the strong man boast of his strength or the rich man boast about his riches, but let him who boasts boast about this: that he understands and knows me."

"Be patient...until the Lord's coming. ...be patient and stand firm"

"do not swear—not by heaven or by earth or by anything else. Let your 'Yes,' be 'yes, and your, 'No,' no"

"So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God."

What the Saved Can Look Forward To

We will have permanent houses in a renewed universe (Isaiah 65:17,22),

We will bear children forever (Deuteronomy 7:13, Psalm 113:9, Isaiah, 59:21),

We will be perfectly satisfied, (Psalm 145:19, Proverbs 13:25, Jeremiah 31:12-14),

We will know and understand God's word perfectly (Jeremiah 31:34),

We will see God's face (Psalm 17:15, Matthew 5:8)

Who Can Be Trusted To Evangelize?

Not everyone has God's Spirit (Jude 1:19), so not everyone can be trusted to preach the true gospel. The gospel teaches that salvation cannot be earned or lost. It cannot be earned because:

1) Faith that leads to salvation is a gift of God, and so not something of man, so neither obedience nor good deeds can earn it (Romans 6:14, 9:10-21, Ephesians 2:8-9, Titus 2:5, Galatians 3:1-5).

2) No one can or will choose to trust God for salvation or love him without God changing and drawing them to himself (Psalm 53:2-3, John 6:44,65).

3) Jesus died for the past and future sins of those he saved (Psalm 103:12, Hebrews 9:24-28).

And salvation cannot be lost because:

1) Those who are saved were predestined to be like his Son.

2) God willed to lose none who he chose; his will is always done.

3) God will not let his chosen be separated from his love.

4) Jesus didn't obey, suffer, and die in vain for those he loved, or

5) lie about having given eternal life to those he said were saved.
