

This is what you must believe if you want to live and be happy forever without any pain: God is a spirit who never lies, is always fair, knows everything, and always gets his way. He is three different people at the same time but they are all God because they are all apart of each other. One of them is named Yahweh, and another is named the Holy Spirit, and another is named Jesus, and Jesus' other name is Christ. We can't totally understand how God can be three people with their own minds at the same time, but remember that just because you can't understand everything you hear doesn't mean it isn't true. God gave the world laws to obey, and the greatest is, **“Love the Lord your God with all your heart”** and the second greatest law is, **“Love each your neighbor like yourself”**. Unless God changes your heart and mind it's not possible to want to please out of love, and without being able to love him you can't obey his laws perfectly. Those who don't love God will always want to do what they want more then what God wants. The only reason they obey him is for rewards or so they won't get punished and they sometimes steal and lie when they become impatient with him. The punishment for not obeying God is to be sent away from him by being killed and put in a place called Hell where you will be in the dark and in pain forever. But because God is loving and forgiving he chose to save some people. But to save people from Hell, God decided that someone must obey him perfectly for them and suffer all the punishment they deserved for disobeying him. That punishment was to be hung on a tree, to bleed, be killed, and suffer forever. Jesus decided he would do this but since he was a spirit he couldn't bleed or be killed, so he had to become a human. “Sinner” means “mark-misser” and a mark-misser is someone who shoots something like an arrow at something like a small scratch or paint-mark but keeps missing it: If you move your arm in the wrong direction even a little you will miss it. That's what it's like to God when you disobey him even a little: it's like you didn't obey any of what he told you to do even if you just disobey him a little. That's also what it's like when you disobey your own parents, like if you lie to them, you've also shown them hatred and dishonored them. Finally, to be forgiven and have eternal life, you must do these things:

>Be sorry to God for disobeying him and desire never to disobey him again,

>Trust that his son died for you.

>Believe that if you ask God to forgive you for breaking his laws, that he immediately will and even for sins you will commit in the future.

>Believe that after he forgives you that he makes for you a spirit that can only obey him and will never die (your spirit is immortal when God returns so will your body).

>Believe that if your body dies that he will bring it back to life just like he did with Jesus and that he will make it so that it is never able to hate him again and will live forever.
