



RADIOGRAPHIC IMAGE CRITIQUE ASSESSMENT FORMAT

Instructions:

1. Apply this assignment to the hospital or private practice at which you have been placed.
2. You are to submit an "Image Critique" of 4 (four) unacceptable radiographs.
3. Each radiograph must be of a different anatomical area with respect to each semesters specific clinical objectives. (Refer Clinical Objectives Guidelines)
4. The radiographs must conform to the format stated below.
5. Seek advice from qualified staffs as necessary.

Selected Images :

- Image 1 :        Incorrect Density                    - an image of high density  
Image 2 :        Incorrect Contrast                    - an image of high contrast

Your image critique is to include the following details:

1. Actual exposure factors used
2. Corrected exposure factors
3. Details explanation of why the original exposure factors were deemed inadequate
4. Methods used to derive the correct factors

- Image 4 :        Unacceptable Positioning Technique  
Image 5 :        Unacceptable Positioning Technique

These two images (images 4 and 5) are to be thoroughly evaluated including:

1. A clear explanation of the correction (s) made
2. The reason (s) for each correction

ALL image critiques MUST include:

1. a comprehensive list of all anatomical parts required to be visualised in the region of interest with respect to the projection in the radiograph
2. an overlay with all anatomy clearly annotated and where necessary, outlined
