What is LGRA? LGRA is sprint racing for Gazehounds. The hounds run 200 yards straight after a lure consisting of a fur bag and squawker. Up to four hounds race a total of three times, called programs. Depending on the order of finish, they may attain national points towards a GRC, Gazehound Racing Championship, title.

Hounds need to be one year of age or older to be entered. They will also need to be registered with LGRA. This can be done by prior to the race meet by sending a photocopy of the hound's registration and a two-dollar fee this also can be done the morning of the race meet along with a late entry. **NO FIRST TIME ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH OUT A PHOTOCOPY OF THE HOUNDS REGISTRATION.**

The hound will receive a LGRA number to be used in entering future LGRA meets. For further information contact Sara Ose, Race Secretary, 763-689-5099, sohoundsborzoi@yahoo.com or see www.lgra.org to register your hound.

All hounds will run muzzled. Please bring your own muzzles and blankets or make arrangements to use other handlers equipment if at all possible.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS: Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds and Sloughi.

PROVISIONAL BREEDS: There are no provisional breeds currently (for more information on provisional status, please see the LGRA website – www.lgra.org).

SILKEN WINDHOUNDS: Silken Windhounds are eligible to run in the concurrent ISWS race meet. Per ISWS Racing rules, they must be pre-registered with that organization's registrar before competing. See www.silkenwindhounds.org/racing.html for more information.

Routes to Race Meet Site:

MN Hwy 65 north from Minneapolis to MN Hwy 95 in Cambridge, then 1/2 mile east to Fairgrounds on left.

or

I-35 to MN Hwy 95 at North Branch, then west 12 miles to fairgrounds on right (at first stoplight in Cambridge).

PLEASE NOTE: The method of starting for this race meet will be **handslip**, except by agreement of handlers of all dogs of any breed, in which case **starting boxes** will be used.

Any hound loose on the racetrack not running the race in progress will be fined \$5.00. Please pick up after yourself and your dog! Thanks!
