The candle is from one of the many quilts that hang in the house.

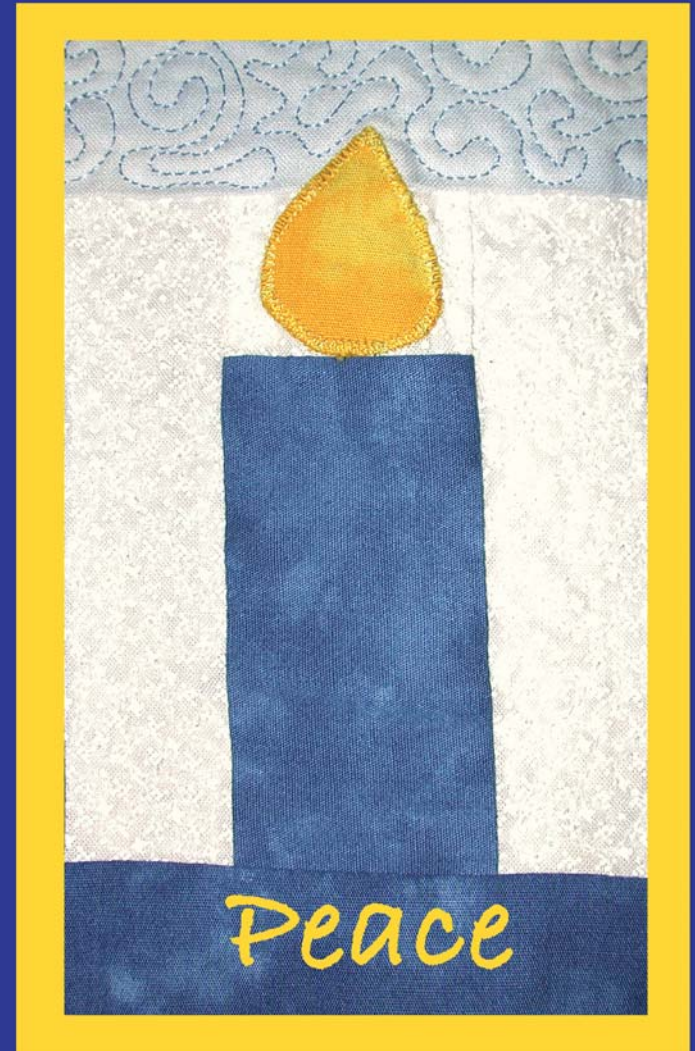
The quilt is pictured here below:
