From I-440, take I-40 W (to Memphis) to the Old Hickory Blvd exit (about 10 miles). Turn L on Old Hickory Blvd and go about 5 miles -- you'll go past Hwy 70 -- until you come to Hwy 100. Turn R on Hwy 100, go across the Harpeth River Bridge and continue for another mile, passing one road on the L. When you reach the 2nd road on the L, turn, on Temple Rd. Go past 3 streets on the L and then turn L on Temple Ridge Dr (4th street, sits in a curve). Go up to the top of the hill. The 2nd street on the L is Woodmere Ct, a cul-de-sac.

Turn L on Murfreesboro Rd and move immediately into the R lane, as you will quickly take the first R on Hickory Woods Dr. Take the 2nd L on Firelight Trail. The house is on the L, about halfway down the street.
