Dick took some notes at the HERI Leadership Retreat we attended on Thursday, July 10. Debbie Strayer was the speaker and gave some words of encouragement to leaders of support groups. Below you will find a few of the points Debbie made that we thought might be helpful to you.

1. General insights: There are 10,000 families in the

- b. Support group leaders are ministers (servant leaders), not dictatorial leaders.
- c. Support group leaders need to be encouragers.
- d. We need to give honor to God for everything we do [boast in the Lord].
- e. Remember that God is completely able to handle any problem.
- f.. Always share the credit.
- g. Always use teamwork.
- h. Be generous focus on others– provide recognition.
- i. Always try to have 2 persons in charge of any task for mutual support.

Again this year I ask you to consider being a member of HERI. Although we are growing in number each year and adding to our events, we still need to support the larger picture. Budget

Due to increased costs, the NCHE Leadership has decided to increase the annual dues for the 2008 – 2009 year from \$15 to \$20 per year per family [\$0.42/month increase]. This is the first dues increase since the initiation of NCHE. Please find attached a handout providing the 2007 – 2008 costs and the 2008 – 2009 BUDGET. Also listed are the Self-Supporting activi-

ties of the group. In addition to the fee increase NCHE will be going to electronic [e-mail] delivery of our News Letter for the 2008 – 2009 year. The monthly newsletters will also be available on our website as in 2007-2008 [geocities.com/nassaucountyhomeeducators]. These actions will bring our operating account back into a positive balance and may allow for

a return to a lower annual fee in the future. The present negative balance is being controlled by certain members holding back their reimbursements until the 2008 – 2009 fees begin to be deposited.
