### Exhibitor/Vendor:

**1. NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS ALLOWED OR SOLD.**

(If anyone is caught drinking alcohol, doing drugs, or selling these items they will be asked to leave for the remainder of the PowWow, and forfeit all fees and deposits.)

**2. Authentic Native American Indian made crafts** only. No non-Native American Indian crafts are allowed. **"NO made in China, Thailand, Bali, etc., products!"** We will make unannounced inspections, and if you have these items on displayed for sale, we will:

- 1. First time, you will be asked to remove the items from your booth.**
- 2. Second time, you will be asked to leave immediately with total loss of booth fees and deposit.**

3. You are responsible for keeping the area around your booth clean!

4. Set-up Time is on Friday, August 31, 2007, after 1 P.M.

5. Please agree in good faith (as is traditional at Pow Wows) to donate one item from your booth, to the Stockton Powwow Committee Raffle.

6. **Exhibitor/Vendor** must fill out and sign the "Holds Harmless" agreement for City of Stockton and turn in with application.

7. **Exhibitor/Vendor** must agree to fill out and turn in after the PowWow the percentage agreement form to the City of Stockton. (3% merchandise and 5% food and non-alcoholic beverages)

8. Absolutely No driving or parking on grass.

9. Parking permits will be issued.

10. No driving on event grounds while event is going on.

11. Breakdown time deadline is 9:00 pm
