Mystery Quilt 2007

Magic Curtain - Finished size: 60" x 78"

Press fabric for more accurate cutting.

On Point Set 5 blocks by 7 blocks. Blocks finish at 6".

Yardage needed:

- □ Background 2¹/₈ yd. light color
- ☐ Medium color 1⅔ yd. total (includes second border and binding)
- Dark 2¹/₂ yd. total (includes first and third border)

(As you cut each set of directions, make a check mark so you will know that you have completed it.)

<u>CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS</u> (WOF = Width of fabric)

BACKGROUND FABRIC:

- Cut 8 strips @ 11/2" x WOF (label 4 patch) includes block B and C
- \Box Cut 5 strips @ 4¹/₂" x WOF;
- Crosscut @ $2\frac{1}{2}$ " forming 72 rectangles @ $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (label **block C**)
- Cut 2 strips @ 21/2" x WOF
- Crosscut 2 strips @ 6¹/₂" x 2¹/₂" forming 8 rectangles (label **block C** or **corner block**)
- Crosscut remaining 6 strips @ 2¹/₂" forming 48-2¹/₂" squares

SETTING AND CORNER TRIANGLES:

- Cut 2 strips @ 9³/₄" x WOF
- Crosscut @ 9³/₄" forming 5 squares @ 9³/₄"
- Cut each square on the diagonal twice forming 20 triangles (You will use the rest of the last strip for the corner triangles.)
- □ Corner triangles: From the remaining strip @9¾" cut two squares@ 5‰" cut on diagonal once forming 4 triangles.

MEDIUM FABRIC:

- \Box Cut 4 strips @ 2¹/₂" x WOF (label **block A**)
- Cut 8 strips @ 1¹/₂" x WOF (label **block A and B**)

DARK FABRIC: Cut 8 strips 21/2" x WOF

- Cut 5 strips @ 2¹/₂" x WOF (label **block A**)
- Cut 3 strips @ 21/2" x WOF (label **block B and C**)

BORDERS

- □ #1 dark fabric: cut 6 strips @ 3" x WOF
- □ #2 medium fabric cut 7 strips @ 11/2" x WOF
- □ #3 dark fabric: cut 7 strips @ 51/2" x WOF
- □ Binding medium fabric cut 8 strips @ 21/2" x WOF

Clue #1 Nine Patch

 \square Remove 5 Dark color strips 2¹/₂"

Remove 4 Medium color strips 21/2"



Make 15

Sew together one Dark, one Medium and one Dark together in a strip. Repeat this once more.
Sew together one Medium, one Dark and one Medium together.

You will have three sets of strips, one having the Dark color in the center and the two others will have the Dark color on either side of the Medium color. Press carefully not to stretch the fabric and always towards the darker color. Cut these strips into $2\frac{1}{2}$ segments.

Tip: Place a line of your ruler on one of the seam lines of this strip segment. This will ensure that you are cutting in a straight line. Sew the three patches together as show in Fig. #1.

 \Box You will need 15 of these 9 Patch blocks, $6\frac{1}{2}$ x $6\frac{1}{2}$.

□ Press these carefully and put aside for now.

Keep the remaining segments as you will need to complete the following blocks. You may also remove the stitching to these remaining unused segments.


