QUILT ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION: Member's quilts **MUST** be pre-registered no later than the March guild meeting (March 10, 2009). Registration forms will be available at guild meetings and will be printed in the newsletter. No quilts will be accepted without a registration form. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!** Pre-registration is necessary so that quilts can be grouped for hanging, making it easier for both viewing and voting. Entries will be limited to 9 quilts per guild member

AWARDS

There will be cash prizes and ribbons awarded to the top 3 quilts in the following categories:

- Viewers Choice (voted by the public)
- Peer's Choice Bed Quilt (voted by the guild)
- Peer's Choice Wall Quilt (voted by the guild)
- Challenge Quilt (voted by the guild)
- Challenge Block (voted by the vendors)

CATEGORIES

- 1. Bed Quilt, Pieced
- 2. Bed Quilt, Appliquéd
- 3. Bed Quilt, Mixed Techniques
- 4. Wall Quilt, Pieced
- 5. Wall Quilt Appliquéd
- 6. Wall Quilt, Mixed Techniques
- 7. Art/Innovative Quilt
- 8. Clothing
- 9. Categories will be further subdivided by individual or duet, hand and machine quilted depending on the number of quilts entered

1. **DEFINITIONS**

- 2. Bed Quilt: Quilt intended for use on a bed.
- 3. Wall Quilt: Quilt intended for display on a wall.
- 4. Pieced: Piecing predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.
- 5. Appliqué: Appliqué predominates over other technique in amount or effect.
- 6. Mixed: A quilt where a fairly even amount of both piecework and appliqué is used to develop the design of the top
- 7. Art/Innovative: An original design reflecting innovative construction and design techniques, theme or subject matter, and/or materials
- 8. Individual: A quilt that has only one individual involved in its completion.
- 9. Duet: A quilt that has two or more persons

involved in its completion. Includes all techniques as well as quilting by a person other than the maker of the top.

It's not too early to start work on the BLOCK CHALLENGE for the 2009 NCN Quilt Show "To The Nines". The theme for the block challenge is "Beyond the Nines" and the rules are very simple.

- Must be 12 ¹/₂" sq, on an **OFF WHITE** background
- Must contain at least nine pieces

The vendors will vote on blocks on Saturday with ribbons to be awarded.

There will be one ballot given per worker per vendor.

All blocks will be given to Community Service

"To The Nines" 2009 QUILT SHOW CHALLENGE "Nine Patch Panache"

It's not too early to start work on the challenge for the 2009 NCN Quilt Show **"To The Nines"**. The theme for the challenge is **"Nine Patch Panache"** and the rules are simple.

- 1. There must be a nine patch somewhere in the quilt.
- 2. Only nine fabrics can be used.
- 3. The finished quilt must measure 39" by 39" (they will be measured)
- 4. There will be two catorgies:
 - a. Those quilts made by individuals
 - b. Those quilts made by a group (a group is 2 or more people)
