Use same formula Just added this to project sheet because it seems like there might for each color: be times when this would be useful - but if I did it this time, I didn't document it. Color Ends Length Total Weaving notes: Warped at 24 epi's in 12 dent reed. Maybe denim 8/2 should have have been fewer. Lace needs multiples of 12 ends. Accented about 15 inches from each end with cross stripe. Watch for doubled threads in shed and watch treadling for doubled tabby.

Sewing and finishing notes: First zigzagged each end before cutting. Hemmed each end. Practice making hem invisible. Washed hot. Ironed.
