ELIGIBLE LIST INFORMATION Competitors can be tested only once during a 12-month period. Competitors' name and address must be submitted within the testing period to be considered for that test administration. candidate's eligibility will be established for 12 months. Eligibility will expire 12 months after it is established unless the needs of the service and conditions of the list warrant a change in the period. Names of successful competitors are merged into the eligible list in order of final score regardless of the test date. The resulting eligible list will be used to fill vacancies at the Department of Justice.
