Dear Parents and Staff:

In accordance with the Asbestos Hazardous Response Act, inspectors completed an asbestos inspection of all school buildings. The inspection was conducted on 3-5 September 2003 in accordance with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) guidelines and the Department of Defense Dependents Schools policy.

Samples of suspected asbestos-containing materials were taken during the inspection and were submitted to a laboratory for analysis. Test results indicate that minor asbestos is present in the following types of materials used in our buildings: vinyl floor tiles in the basement, roof tiles and insulation used in the steam pipes in our boiler room. The inspectors recommended there is no reason to remove either of these materials at this time. As required by the EPA, a periodic surveillance program is in effect to monitor the condition of the asbestos materials.

Copies of the inspection report, periodic surveillance records, and the school's Asbestos management plan are kept in the school office. These documents are available for your review.
