Horses to be judged on way of going and manners. No backing. Open to horses who have won less than twelve (12) blue ribbons in performance riding classes,

168 \$100 NJ Bred Standardbred Pleasure Horse - Three Gait under saddle - Junior Exhibitor to Ride - No limit on ribbons won. Horses will be asked to work both ways of the ring at a walk, trot/jog/or intermediate gait, canter/lope Horses to be judged on way of going and manners. No backing.

169 \$100 NJ Bred Standardbred - Pleasure Driving Open - Horses to be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, slow trot or intermediate gait, and strong trot. Horses will be judged on their way of going and ability to give a pleasurable drive Backing may be required. Horses may be headed by a groom in the line-up. Open to all horses regardless of points or ribbons won.

170 \$100 NJ Bred Standardbred - Country Pleasure Driving Open—Horses to be shown both ways at a flat walk, trot or intermediate gait, with emphasis on the walk. Extreme speed to be penalized. Must stand quietly on the rail and while lined up and back readily. To be judged 75% on performance and apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, 25% on conformation and neatness of attire Open to all horses regardless of points or ribbons won.

171 \$100 NJ Bred Standardbred - Over Cross Rails - To be shown over a course of no less than 4 obstacles. Cross rails 18" or under. Open to all horses regardless of points or ribbons won. Horses can trot or canter.

172 \$100 NJ Bred Standardbred - Over Fences - To be shown over a course of not less than six obstacles. Not to exceed 2'6". Open to all horses regardless of points or ribbons won. Horses can trot or canter.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS -
NEW JERSEY BRED NON RACING BREEDER AWARDS
AND
NEW JERSEY BRED ALL BREED HORSE SHOW**

(a) With the exception of non-pari-mutuel racing, in order to qualify for year-end non-racing breeder awards, a horse must enter at least three different New Jersey horse shows under three different judges. **Futurities must be held with a minimum of three judges.** Furthermore, there must be at least two horses entered, shown and judged in each class.

1 If a horse is entered in a New Jersey horse show with only one horse in its class, it will not receive any points towards breeder awards, but the show will count as one of its three required New Jersey horse shows.

2 If a designated breeding class at a pointed horse show does not fill, the Grand or Reserve Champion class may be counted for New Jersey Bred points at the discretion of the breed organization, if the organization has made this decision at the beginning of the year.

(b) A New Jersey Bred horse is:

1 Any foal dropped in the State of New Jersey, except for the foals of transient mares. A mare will be considered to be a transient mare if she does not reside in the State of New Jersey for at least 120 consecutive days including the day of foaling. The owner of a mare may be asked to submit proof of such residence to the individual breed groups.

2 Any foal resulting from an embryo transfer from a mare who resides 120 cumulative days in the State of New Jersey providing blood typing of the mare, stallion and foal is carried out in New Jersey, and embryo transfer is agreeable to the national registry of the breed.

3 The get of any stallion standing only in New Jersey during the breeding season of the year in which the foal was conceived. Stallions standing in New Jersey must breed only in New Jersey for that year's breeding season; or

4 Foals resulting from the transport of semen from a stallion standing the full season in the State of New Jersey, providing blood typing of the stallion, mare, and foal is carried out to authenticate parentage, and semen transport is agreeable to the national registry of the breed.

(c) In order to qualify for New Jersey non-racing breeder awards, at least one owner shall be a member in good standing of the New Jersey Bred association represented on

Any horse that shows in Open Hunter Under Saddle can go back and show the succeeding year in Young Hunter Under Saddle classes if age eligible.

217 \$100 NJ Bred Young Conformation Hunter Under Saddle—Open to all N.J.B.H.A. registered horses five (5) year old and younger with no restrictions as to previous showing experience. Horses are to be stripped for confirmation. (60% on performance and 40% on conformation)

218 \$100 NJ Bred Green Hunter- Over Fences—2' - 2'3"
Open to all N.J.B.H.A. registered horses showing in any junior, amateur, or open division at 2' to 2'3"

219A \$50 NJ Bred Hunter—2'6" - 2'9" - Over Fences
219B \$50 NJ Bred Hunter—2'6" - 2'9" - Over Fences
Open to all NJBHA registered horses showing in any Jr./Amateur/ Open—2'6" to 2'9" division. To be shown over a minimum of six fences not to exceed 2'9"

220 \$100 NJ Bred Hunter—2'6" - 2'9" - Under Saddle—Open to NJBHA registered horses showing in any Jr/Amateur/Open 2'6" to 2'9" Division

221A \$50 NJ Bred Hunter—2'9" - 3" - Over Fences
221B \$50 NJ Bred Hunter—2'9" - 3" - Over Fences
Open to NJBHA registered horses showing in any Jr/Amateur/Open 2'9" to 3" Division

222 \$100 NJ Bred Hunter—2'9" - 3' - Under Saddle—Open to any NJBHA registered horses showing in any Jr/Amateur/Open 2'9" - 3'

the New Jersey Equine Advisory Board, which represents the particular breed group in which the breeder is competing. In the case of a leased horse, the lessee shall hold such membership. Nominations for Jersey Bred should not close before one month prior to the New Jersey All Breed Horse Show.

(d) Individual breed groups are responsible for the certification of eligible horses and the tabulation of breeder awards points and must submit them to the New Jersey Department of Agriculture no later than November 30 of the year in which they are earned.

(e) Individual breed groups may require that additional conditions be met to qualify for non-racing breeder awards. Such conditions must not be in opposition to the intent of this section and must be approved and recorded by the New Jersey Equine Advisory Board and New Jersey State Board of Agriculture each year prior to the show and breeding season.

(f) Each breed's share of the year-end money is determined by:

1 The number of animals shown at the New Jersey All Breed Horse Show.

2 The number of horses entered in specific breed futurities. For a futurity run by a New Jersey breed group at a separate location, each New Jersey Bred horse's owner must sign an owner's eligibility form which, along with a photocopy of the entry blank, must be sent by the breed group to the New Jersey Department of Agriculture within two weeks of the show.

3 The number of animals who race at the Trotting Bred Pony Association races. All owners must sign an eligibility certification form which, along with a photocopy of the entry blank, must be sent by the Trotting Bred Association to the Department of Agriculture within two weeks of the race.

(g) For the purpose of obtaining a year-end total of competitors for each breed group, no animal is to be counted more than once by one breed group. Horses who are registered with more than one breed group may be entered in any division for which they are qualified

(h) Individual breed groups are responsible for supervising and certifying to the adherence to the provisions of this section.

(i) The New Jersey Department of Agriculture will accept the decision of the individual breed groups regarding which horses are qualified to receive non-racing breeder awards as well as the tabulation of breeder award points. Any disagreement with the decisions of the breed groups must be presented to the officer and/or directors of the particular group in question. The New Jersey Department of Agriculture will abide by the decision of the breed group officers and/or directors unless fraud or misfeasance is shown.

2:34-2.2 Conduct of the New Jersey Bred All Breed Horse Show

(a) The New Jersey Bred All Breed Horse Show, or any other show conducted by the New Jersey Department of Agriculture, shall be governed as follows:

1 It is the policy of the New Jersey Department of Agriculture to accept the decision of the individual breed groups regarding which horses are qualified to enter and show at the New Jersey Bred All Breed Horse Show, and to receive non-racing breeder awards, as well as the tabulation of breeder award points. Such decision and tabulations must not be

in opposition to the intent of this chapter. Any disagreements with the decision of the group, must be presented to the officers and/or directors of the particular breed group.

2 Any questions arising which are not covered in the following rules shall be referred to the Equine Advisory Board Breeder Incentive Committee for final decision.

3 For any entry to be accepted, the horse or pony must be registered with its New Jersey breed association and be a certified New Jersey Bred. In addition, the owner or one lessee shall be a member in good standing with his or her New Jersey breed association represented on the New Jersey Equine Advisory board. Every horse shall be entered under its registered name and the name of its rightful owner or lessee.

4 No entry will be accepted without a copy of a negative Coggins test of the date accepted by the New Jersey Department of Agriculture. Foals six months and under are allowed to use the Coggins test of their dam. Note: Do Not Send Originals.

5 Copies of the Coggins test report and the horse's registration papers shall be attached to all entry forms along with the owners Eligibility Declaration Form.

6 Foals dropped later than two months prior to show date will not be accepted as entries. No horse under three years of age may compete in under saddle classes, except when approved by their National Association rules and regulations.

7 No entries or stall reservations will be accepted unless payment by check, credit card, or money order is received by the show secretary.

8 All entries must be postmarked (meter marks not accepted) no later than the closing date of entries in order for entry to appear in the program. A check, credit card, or money order (no cash) for the entry and stall fees must accompany the entry blank. No horse will be allowed to compete until all fees are paid.

(i) Post entries will be accepted at two times the regular fee. Any entry received postmarked after closing date will be considered a post entry and will be accepted at two times the regular entry fee provided it meets all other New Jersey Bred requirements. Entry fees must be paid by money order, credit card, or check. No cash will be accepted. Post entries not completely in order when received will not be accepted.

(ii) Phone entries are not accepted.

9 No refunds once a horse has performed in a class, or if entered and not exhibited, after the start of the show .

10 All entry and stall fees will be refunded upon request before the closing date of entries, minus a \$10.00 office charge per horse. After this date, entry fees only will be refunded upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate however, there will be a charge of \$10 per horse entered. The actual refund will not be made until after completion of the show. There is a penalty of \$30 if a check is refused.

11 Exhibitor numbers will be provided for each entry in this show at the Secretary's booth. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make certain the proper horse is entered in the proper class with the proper number. Horses entered in the wrong class will be disqualified.

12 Each breed will be judged according to the rules and regulations of its national breed association. **All classes must conform to the specifications of the National Associa-**

HUNTERBRED DIVISION—NOTE STARTING TIME 11:00 a.m. JUDGE: Mike Maxwell

All horses must be registered with the New Jersey Bred Hunter Association, Inc. through Linda Kulley, 141 Old Georgetown Road, Princeton, NJ 08540, (609) 921-8825. For more information contact Diane Miller, 415 Pemberton Road, Southampton, NJ 08088. Classes will be judged in accordance with the rules of the New Jersey Bred Hunter Association, Inc. Eligible animals must be a Thoroughbred or Half Thoroughbred whose sire or dam is registered through the Jockey Club, Performance Horse Registry, or any International Thoroughbred registry. Also eligible are Warmblood Sport horses whose sire or dam or papered with any European or American registries of the following breeds: Hanovarian, Trakehner, Oldenburg, Swedish Warmblood, Danish, Dutch or Selle Francais.

IN HAND DIVISION Classes will begin at 11:00

To be judged on suitability to become hunters with the emphasis on bone, substance, manners, quality and way of going. BLEMISHES AND CUTS NOT TO COUNT. All classes must be moved on the line at a walk and trot and viewed from front, side and rear. All in-hand horses must be shown in a bridle, including yearlings. Mares suitable to produce Hunters are to be judged the same as other in-hand classes with the exception the MARES CANNOT BE PENALIZED FOR LAMENESS BUT THEY WILL BE JOGGED.

Horses must be three years old and older to compete in Under Saddle Classes. All Jr. Exhibitor riders entered in any type Hunter Class must wear tested and approved protective head gear at ALL TIMES when mounted on the show grounds. There will be a \$10.00 per horse schooling fee for the schooling session that will be held before the Fence Class.

PERFORMANCE CLASSES

Ponies must be three years and older to compete in saddle classes. All Performance ponies over 6 years of age must have USEF or WPSCA Measurement cards or be presented for measurement before the class. All Junior Exhibitors must wear ASTM tested and approved head gear at all times when mounted on the show grounds. Adults may ride if these classes. There will be a \$10.00 per pony schooling fee for schooling classes.

Ponies not exceeding 13.2 will jump 2'. Animals exceeding 13.2 hands but not over 14.2 hands shall jump 2'3".

tion list of classes. Those breeds which do not have a national affiliation will be judged by their New Jersey State organization rules.

13 No horse shall be shown in any class at this show if it has been administered, in any manner, any foreign substance. A foreign substance is any medication. There will be spot testing by urinalysis and/or blood testing. Any entry found positive will be disqualified and will forfeit all awards for the New Jersey Bred All Breed Horse Show and New Jersey Bred year-end awards in the current year. Refusal to allow testing will automatically subject the horse to disqualification .

14 Classes designated as combined may be split if entries warrant; full prize money will be paid in both categories, providing the breed organization has not exceeded the designated prize money; otherwise prize money will be split.

15 Two horses are required to fill a class at the All Breed Horse Show. If Classes with A and B sections do not have two entries each, A and B sections will be combined. Other classes will be combined only as specified in the prize list. Two horses are required to be shown and judged in order to receive both prize money and points.

Prize money will be paid as follows:

Four horses or more in class	50%	25%	15%	10%
Three horses in class	50%	25%	15%	
Two horses in class		50%	25%	
One horse in class	50%	- No Points		

16 If only one horse reports for judging, show money will be paid but no points will be given. However, that horse shown and judged will receive credit for the All Breed Horse Show one of the horse's required three New Jersey shows.

17 In all classes, all riders and handlers appearing in the ring shall be neatly and properly attired according to the requirements of their national breed organization. Protective headgear is required in all jumping classes.

18 Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials by owner, trainer, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his or her entry and other fees.

19 The Horse Park of New Jersey at Stone Tavern, Inc., The Department of Agriculture, the New Jersey Bred All Breed Horse Show committee and the New Jersey Equine Advisory Board will not be responsible for injury to any person, horse or property incurred on the grounds.

20 The veterinarian and/or steward shall be responsible for measuring height of entries and weight of shoes.

21 The veterinarian certificate excusing a horse from competition must be dated on or before the start of its competition and be postmarked within five days of the competition. This must be supplied on the veterinarian's letterhead and have the signature of the veterinarian .

22 Prize money will be mailed at a later date, no money can be paid without the winner's Social Security number, please be certain that it is on your entry blank.

23 Any appeal from the provisions of this section shall be made within 20 days of the horse show date, or within 20 days of notification to owners of a decision.

(i) All appeals to the New Jersey Department of Agriculture or breed groups are final if decided in accordance with this section or the breed group rules. Should there be a conflict between rules, this section shall be deemed superior and superseding of all other rules.
