


Infected mosquito feeds on dog




Microfilaria develop in the mosquito into infective larvae and migrate to the mouth parts





Mosquito takes in the circulating microfilaria when it feeds



Adult worms mate and produce eggs which develop into microfilaria. The microfilaria circulate in the blood, mostly at night.







After about 2 months they have matured into adult worms.
